The Leadership Development Year (LDY) is a development. formation and ministry placement programme from St Peter's Church and Family of Churches

It is an eleven month programme of theological training, leadership development and ministry placement. As a candidate you will be linked to a

to help you grow. The programme consists of formation, where you will be mentored and discipled to grow deeper roots in your faith.

The LDY programme will position you for lifelong leadership and ministry work. LDY helps you to grow in five overlapping areas:

- Calling: Growing in the sense of who God has made us to be, what he has called us to do, and the transformative relationship with God sustains both.
 - Focus Areas: Hearing God's Voice, Humility, Identity, Presence, Purpose.
- 2 Character: Growing in love, holiness, self-awareness and integrity in the likeness of Christ.
 - Focus Areas: Trust, Strength, Courage, Honesty, Integrity, Commitment, Resilience, Moral Courage, Character Awareness, Humility
- Competence: Growing in skills and competencies necessary for effective service and leadership.
 Focus Area: Decision Making, Constructive Feedback, Delegation.
 - Management of Others, Managing Expectations, Confidence, Conflict Resolution, Forming Vision, Turning Vision into Action
- 4 Charismata: Growing in your giftings for the building up of the church.
 - Focus Areas: Spiritual Intelligence, Walking in the Power of God, Personal Discipline, Gifts of the Spirit, Biblical Overview, Ministry, Prophecy.
- 5 <u>Chemistry</u>: Growing in relational, emotional and cultural intelligence, and in the skills necessary to lead with empathy and effectiveness.
 - Focus Areas: Relational and Emotional Intelligence, Understanding Others, Empathy Soft Skills Increasing Your Leadership Impact

Weekend Away

There will be a weekend away (included in price) at the beginning of the year.

Learning Trip (self directed)

During you will be encouraged to plan and fundraise an overseas learning trip to take place immediately after the LDY finishes. The purpose of this to gain experience of the global church and learn from Christians in other contexts. You will be coached in the planning of this trip – previous learning trips have included work with the church in Hong Kong, South Africa, Brasil and Malaysia.

Conferences

In the second term there are two conferences that you will be invited to attend; Summit and Leadership Conference.

Focus

During Focus as a Church we go away and camp for a long weekend at the end of July. As LDY group you will attend.

finance/housing

The charge for LDV is 780. However the full cost to run LDV is higher, if participants are able to contribute more, this helps to keep the cost down for others. Additionally if you want to support someone in doing LDV financially or housing, please be in touch. This covers all course material, breakfasts, training and development trips and other costs; but not the learning trip.

Half of the payment is due on 1 September 2025 and other half by 1 March 2026. If this is not possible we can arrange a payment plan . Partial bursaries will be available for those who would not be able to afford the full cost.

You will be responsible for making your own housing arrangements, however we will be putting together a list of families who would be happy to host a lodger for reduced rent. Be in touch with us if you need any help in this area.

There will be an opportunity for you to find part-time work alongside LDY, but we strongly encourage candidates to find people who may be able to financially support their year.

Follow the <u>link</u> and complete the form by **20 June 2025.**Once we've received your application, we will be in touch within two weeks inviting you for an interview.

Following this interview, we may invite you for a secondary interview with your Ministry Leader. We will reach a decision regarding your application as soon as possible thereafter.

FAQ's

1) How do I apply for the Leadership Development Year (LDY)?

To apply, download an application form from the website and return it to melissa.taleni@ stpetersbrighton.org by 20 June 2025.

2) How much does LDY cost?

LDY costs £780 to be paid by 1 March 2026. This covers all course material, breakfasts, activities and other costs, but not learning trip.

3) Will I be paid by St Peter's during my LDY?

St Peter's will not pay you any money during the LDY - instead we encourage you to raise funds through friends and family to support you over the year or look for a lob that will cover all the rest of your monthly outgoings.

4) Which area of ministry will my ministry placement be in?

We will endeavour to place people in an area of ministry which fits their gifts and passions, and will discuss this with candidates during the interview process.

5) What about after the LDY? Will I be offered a job at St Peter's?

Unfortunately, no roles are guaranteed following LDV. In the past we have had candidates go on and do different roles, both ministry and non-ministry related. We have had candidates pursue ordination, lead ministries, become school teachers and other non-ministry related jobs. LDV positions you for whatever the next chapter in your life.

6) Will I get an academic qualification at the end of the year?

You will not receive a formal qualification, however the year will provide you with an excellent basis if you were to go on to study Theology.

7) How much academic work will there be?

There will be weekly lectures and classes, background reading and one essay per

8) Will I be given housing as part of the course?

No, you will be responsible for finding housing for yourself for the year, however we are putting together a list of families who would be happy to host a lodger. Be in touch with us if you need any help in this area.

9) Will I still do my placement day in a department during the term breaks?

You will have break over Christmas and Easter from both the training and your ministry placement.

10) Who will line manage me?

At the beginning of the year you will have a line manager who will be assigned to you based on the ministry placement you have been allocated to.

11) Will I receive continued career and professional development?

We hope during the LDY year you will be able to make most of the support and mentorship. However, there will be a member of staff who could meet up with you informally after the year.
